

Schedule: August 2011 to July 2013

Location: WIS 21 Interchange, US 41 mainline from 1500 feet north of Witzel Avenue, to the US 45 Interchange.

Description: This project involves the reconstruction of the WIS 21 interchange to pass over US 41. The interchange will be completely reconstructed to include roundabouts at ramp terminals and at the WIS 21 intersections with Washburn and Koeller Streets. This project also includes the reconstruction of mainline US 41 from Witzel Avenue to the US 45 Interchange including new bridges over Lake Butte des Morts and Sawyer Creek. The work on the Lake Butte des Mort Causeway will include a recreational trail along the east side of US 41 crossing over the water.

July 8 to July 12: Crews completed permanent signing and median freeway lighting on US 41 between WIS 21 and US 45. Crews continued staining bridges and retaining walls throughout the project.

July 15 to July 19: Crews will complete concrete staining on bridges and retaining walls, and also complete final signing and pavement marking.

Traffic impacts: The northbound and southbound shoulders of US 41 are closed between US 45 and Witzel Avenue. Northbound US 41 will be reduced to two, 12-foot lanes between 9th Avenue and US 45. Southbound US 41 between US 45 and Witzel Avenue will be reduced to two, 12-foot lanes in each direction.

Traffic impacts: The northbound and southbound shoulders of US 41 are closed between US 45 and Witzel Avenue. Northbound US 41 will be reduced to two, 12-foot lanes between 9th Avenue and US 45. Southbound US 41 between US 45 and Witzel Avenue will be reduced to two, 11-foot lanes in each direction. US 41 will be reduced to one lane in each direction between US 45 and Witzel Avenue between the hours of 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. nightly July 8 through July 12. The US 45 ramps to southbound US 41 will be closed between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. nightly July 9 through July 11; the detour will utilize US 41 north to WIS 76.
