**US 41 Project lane closures for October 15 – October 19**

*Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region is announcing US 41 Project lane restrictions for October 15 – October 19 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Drivers should be aware of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits in both counties. WisDOT urges all motorists to use caution while traveling through any work zone.

**Winnebago County**

WIS 26

October 15 – 19:

- A single lane of southbound WIS 26, between Poberezny Road and Planeview Road, will close Monday, October 15 through Friday, October 19 from 5 a.m. to 5 p.m.

**Brown County**

Scheuring Road – Oneida Street

October 15 and 17:

- Various lanes of northbound US 41, beginning two miles south of Scheuring Road to Hansen Road, will close overnight Monday, October 15 and Wednesday, October 17 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. for setting bridge girders.

October 16 – 17:

- Various lanes of southbound US 41, from Hansen Road to two miles south of Scheuring Road, will close overnight Tuesday, October 16 and Wednesday, October 17 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. for median work.

Lombardi Avenue – I-43

October 15 – 19:

- Various lanes of north and southbound US 41, between Lombardi Avenue and I-43, will close overnight Monday, October 15 through Thursday, October 18 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. and Friday, October 19 from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. for setting temporary barrier wall and bridge work.

October 17:

- The southbound US 41 off-ramp to Dousman Street will close overnight Wednesday, October 17 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for grading and asphalt paving.

WIS 29

October 15 – 19:

- Various lanes of eastbound WIS 29, between County FF and Packerland Drive, will close Monday, October 15 through Thursday, October 18 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. and Friday, October 19 from 8 a.m. to noon. In addition, westbound WIS 29 will close Monday, October 15 through Thursday, October 18 from 4 a.m. to 2 p.m. and Friday, October 19 from 4 a.m. to 10 a.m.

October 18:

- A single lane of east and westbound WIS 29, between US 41 and Taylor Street, will close Thursday, October 18 from 8 a.m. to noon for landscaping in the median.

Lakeview Drive bridge

October 15 – 19:

- Various lanes of north and southbound US 41, between I-43 and Lineville Road, will close overnight Monday, October 15 through Thursday, October 18 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. and Friday, October 19 from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. for work on the Lakeview Drive bridge over US 41.

October 15:

- The northbound I-43 to southbound US 41 ramp will close overnight, Monday, October 15 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured north on US 41 to Lineville Road and use Lineville Road to access southbound US 41.

October 17:

- Southbound US 41, between Lineville Road and Velp Avenue, and the southbound US 41 on-ramp from Lineville Road will close overnight Wednesday, October 17 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. The detour route will be west on Lineville Road to Velp Avenue, southeast on Velp Avenue to US 41.

October 18:

- Northbound US 41, between Velp Avenue and Lineville Road, will close overnight Thursday, October 18 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. The northbound US 41 on-ramp from Velp Avenue, and the northbound I-43 to northbound US 41 ramp will also be closed.

- Northbound US 41 traffic will be detoured north on Velp Avenue to Lineville Road, east on Lineville Road to US 41.

- Northbound US 41 traffic wanting to enter southbound I-43 will use the entrance ramp from Velp Avenue.

- Northbound I-43 traffic wanting to enter northbound US 41 will exit I-43 to southbound US 41 to Velp Ave, follow Velp Avenue north to Lineville Road, east on Lineville Road to US 41.

I-43/Leo Frigo Memorial Bridge

Brown County

I-43 at the Leo Frigo Memorial Bridge is reduced to a single lane of traffic with speeds reduced to 55 mph in both directions over a 3.5-mile segment of the highway through November 2012.

Expect significant travel delays.
