US 41 Project lane closures for December 10 – December 14

Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing US 41 Project lane restrictions for December 10 – December 14 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Drivers should be aware of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits in both counties. WisDOT urges all motorists to use caution while traveling through any work zone. Details of all closures are included below.

Winnebago County

US 41

Drivers will encounter overnight single lane closures on southbound US 41, from Cecil Street to US 45, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. In addition, northbound US 41, from 9th Avenue to US 45, will have overnight single lane closures on Monday, December 10 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Brown County

WIS 29

Drivers should anticipate daytime and overnight single lane closures on east and westbound WIS 29, between County FF and Taylor Street, throughout the week.

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
