US 41 Project lane closures for March 18 – March 22

Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing US 41 Project lane restrictions for March 18 – March 22 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Drivers should be aware of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits in both counties and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone.

Details of all closures are included below.

Winnebago County

US 41

The majority of 12 miles of highway, from 9th Avenue to Breezewood Lane, has restricted shoulders and lane widths. The speed limit on US 41 between 9th Avenue and US 45 is reduced to 55 mph in both directions.

On March 20 and 21 between the hours of 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. drivers should anticipate single lane closures on US 41 northbound between WIS 45 and Cecil St. for moving temporary barrier wall.

On March 20 and 21 between the hours of 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. drivers should anticipate single lane closures on US 41 between WIS 114 and Breezewood Lane for moving temporary barrier wall

On March 21 and 22 between the hours of 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. drivers should expect single lane closures on US 41 southbound between WIS 45 and WIS 21 for work zone access.

Brown County

US 41

Drivers will encounter 11-foot travel lanes and reduced shoulders in multiple locations along a 10-mile segment of highway. The speed limit is reduced to 55 mph from just south of Scheuring Road to I-43.

On Monday, March 18 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. drivers should anticipate single lane closures on US 41 northbound between Mason St. and Velp Ave. and US 41 southbound between I-43 and Memorial Drive to address settlement under US 41 due to a pipe crossing.

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
