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US 41 Project lane closures for March 22 – March 29

Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing US 41 Project lane restrictions for March 22 – March 29 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Drivers should be aware of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits in both counties and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone.

Details of all closures are included below.

Winnebago County

US 41

Drivers should anticipate overnight single lane closures on northbound US 41 between US 45 and Cecil Street on Monday, March 25, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Overnight single lane closures will also occur on southbound US 41 between WIS 114 and Breezewood Lane on Monday, March 25, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. In addition, there will be overnight single lane closures on southbound US 41 between US 45 and WIS 21 on Wednesday, March 27, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Brown County

US 41

All lanes of US 41 northbound from WIS 29 (Shawano Ave.) north to Velp Ave. will be entirely closed from 8 p.m. Friday, March 22 through 5 a.m. Monday, March 25. The southbound lanes will remain open. During this closure, northbound traffic will have to use the following signed detours or seek alternate routes:

- US 41 to WIS 172 eastbound to I 43 northbound to US 41
- US 41 to WIS 29 to Military Ave. north to Velp Ave. west to US 41

Both the WIS 29 (Shawano Ave.) on-ramp to northbound US 41 and the WIS 54 (Mason St.) on ramp to northbound US 41 are also closed. The detour for WIS 29 eastbound to US 41 northbound is WIS 29 to Military Ave. north to Velp Ave. west to US 41.

In addition, drivers will encounter an overnight single lane closure on southbound US 41 between I 43 and Memorial Drive on Sunday, March 24 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

WIS 29

Drivers should anticipate daytime single lane closures on the eastbound and westbound WIS 29 between County FF and Packerland Drive on Monday, March 25 from 8 a.m. and 2 p.m.

I-43/Leo Frigo Bridge

Brown County - I-43 southbound on the Leo Frigo Memorial Bridge is reduced to a single lane of traffic with speeds reduced to 55 mph starting Tuesday, March 26 through July 2013. Expect significant travel delays.

Scheuring Road/US 41 Interchange, northbound US 41 entrance ramp

Drivers should anticipate a by-pass lane closure at the Scheuring Road entrance ramp to northbound US 41 to begin Monday, March 25 and continue throughout the week. The closure is part of the northbound US 41 entrance ramp modification at Scheuring Road to improve traffic operations. All westbound traffic will need to enter the roundabout to access the ramp to northbound US 41.

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
