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**US 41 Project lane closures for May 13 – May 17**

*Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing US 41 Project lane restrictions for May 13 – May 17 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Drivers should be aware of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits in both counties and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone.

Details of all closures are included below.

**Winnebago County**

**US 41**

Drivers will encounter 11-foot travel lanes, reduced shoulders, and a reduced speed limit to 55 mph from US 45 to Witzel Avenue.

**Brown County**

**US 41**

Drivers can anticipate various overnight single lane closures on southbound and northbound US 41 between Grant Street and Lineville Road throughout the week of May 13-17 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. In addition, drivers can anticipate ramp closures this week. They include:

- **Tuesday, May 14** – Southbound US 41 on-ramp from Ashland Avenue will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- **Tuesday, May 14** – Southbound US 41 on-ramp from County G will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- **Wednesday, May 15** – Southbound US 41 on-ramp from Velp Avenue will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- **Thursday, May 16** – Northbound US 41 off-ramp to Scheuring Road will be closed from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

**WIS 29**

Drivers can anticipate single lane closures on eastbound WIS 29 between County J and Packerland Drive, Monday, May 13 through Thursday, May 16 from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. and from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Friday will have the same single lane closure from 8 a.m. to noon. Packerland Drive at eastbound WIS 29 will also be closed Monday through Friday from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Westbound WIS 29 between Packerland Drive and County J will have single lane closures Wednesday through Friday from 3 a.m. to 2 p.m. On Thursday, May 16, westbound WIS 29 between Taylor Street and northbound US 41 ramps will have a left lane closure from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

**WIS 29 Tub girders**

Steel tub girders will be lift and set to construct the WIS 29/41 interchange flyover ramps over the next few weeks. Drivers can expect various full overnight closures of US 41, WIS 29 and/or

nearby ramps during these lifts. WisDOT will send a road closure alert and suggested detour to media, [www.US41Wisconsin.gov](http://www.US41Wisconsin.gov), and social media a day prior to the expected girder lift. Tub girder lifts are weather dependent and subject to change. ### **I-43/Leo Frigo Bridge**

Brown County - Southbound I-43 at the Leo Frigo Memorial Bridge is reduced to a single lane of traffic with speeds reduced to 55 mph over a 3.5-mile segment of the highway through July 2013. The southbound I-43 off-ramp to Webster Avenue is closed through mid-May. Also, the southbound I-43 on-ramp from Atkinson Drive is closed until June 28, 2013. Expect significant travel delays.
