

*Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing US 41 Project lane restrictions for May 27 – May 31 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Drivers should be aware of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits in both counties and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone.

Details of all closures are included below.

**Winnebago County**

US 41

Drivers will encounter 11-foot travel lanes, reduced shoulders, and a reduced speed limit to 55 mph from US 45 to Witzel Avenue.

**Brown County**

US 41

Drivers should anticipate various, overnight single lane closures on southbound and northbound US 41 along the entire Brown County corridor from two miles south of Scheuring Road to Lineville Road. Drivers can also anticipate ramp closures, including:

- Overnight closure of the southbound US 41 on-ramp from Velp Avenue on Wednesday, May 29 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Full ramp closure of northbound US 41 off-ramp to Ashland Avenue Wednesday, May 29, to mid-June. The alternate route is northbound US 41 to WIS 172 to Ashland Ave.

Lane closures can vary along the corridor, so drivers are urged to pay attention to road signs, slow down and use caution when entering any work zone. The US 41 Project plans to have at least one lane of traffic open at all times on both northbound and southbound US 41 during construction. This does not include shutdowns by local authorities for accidents or natural disasters.

WIS 29

Drivers can expect single lane closures on eastbound WIS 29 between County J and Packerland Drive, Tuesday, May 28 through Friday, May 31 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Westbound WIS 29 between Packerland Drive and County J will have single lane closures Tuesday through Thursday from 6 p.m. to 2 p.m. There will also be single lane closures on northbound and southbound Packerland Drive Tuesday through Friday from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. The southbound US 41 off-ramp to WIS 29 will also be closed on Wednesday, May 30, from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

In addition, there will be a full closure of westbound WIS 29 between northbound and southbound US 41 ramps on Friday, May 31 from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. Detour as follows:

- Westbound WIS 29 traffic to travel north on US 41 to Velp Avenue, travel west on Velp Avenue to access southbound US 41, and follow southbound US 41 to westbound WIS 29.

### WIS 29 Tub girders

Over the next few weeks, steel tub girders will be lift and set to construct the WIS 29/US 41 interchange flyover ramps. Drivers can expect various full overnight closures of US 41, WIS 29 and/or nearby ramps during these lifts. WisDOT will send a road closure alert and suggested detour to media, [www.US41Wisconsin.gov](http://www.US41Wisconsin.gov) , and social media a day prior to the expected girder lift. Tub girder lifts are weather dependent and subject to change. ### I-43/Leo Frigo Bridge

Brown County - Southbound I-43 at the Leo Frigo Memorial Bridge is reduced to a single lane of traffic with speeds reduced to 55 mph over a 3.5-mile segment of the highway through July 2013.

Two ramps are also closed on the bridge:

- The southbound I-43 on-ramp from Atkinson Drive is closed until June 28, 2013
- The northbound I-43 on-ramp from Webster Ave. is closed Tuesday, May 28, until the end of July
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**All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.**
