## **US 41 Project Winter 2015 scheduled work**

*Last weekly construction update until February 2015*

### **Brown County**

#### **US 41 Glory Road to Ninth Street, Oneida Street (County AAA) Interchange**

**Schedule:**

August 2013 to July 2016

**Length:**

US 41 mainline 4.3 miles (Glory Road to Ninth Street); Hansen Road - 0.1 mile; Oneida Street (County AAA) – 0.6 miles

**Location:**

US 41 from Glory Road to Ninth Street, including the Oneida Street (County AAA) interchange and Hansen Road bridge.

**US 41 Glory Road to Ninth Street, Oneida Street (County AAA) Interchange Schedule:**  
August 2013 to July 2016

**Length:**

US 41 mainline 4.3 miles (Glory Road to Ninth Street); Hansen Road - 0.1 mile; Oneida Street (County AAA) – 0.6 miles

**Location:**

US 41 from Glory Road to Ninth Street, including the Oneida Street (County AAA) interchange and Hansen Road bridge.

**Winter 2014/2015:**

Contractor will continue retaining wall work, setting girders and abutment work. Contractor will continue noise panel placement from WIS 172 to Cormier.

**Traffic Impacts:**

Parkview Road will be closed to through traffic under US 41 for 45 days starting November 24.

### **I-43 Early Structures/Early Fill**

**Schedule:**

September 2013 through May 2015.

**Length:**

**Location:**

US 41/I-43 Interchange

**Description of project:**

This project will begin construction of the flyover bridges and retaining walls for the new US 41/I-43 Interchange.

**Winter 2014/2015:**

Parapet construction will continue on the flyover bridges at I-43.

**Traffic Impacts:**

Traffic may be flagged daily on Weitor Drive for temporary construction access and crossings.

**Motorists are advised to use caution and remain alert when driving through any work zone.**
