## **Hazardous ice near the Duck Creek I-41 bridges in Brown County**

*Construction makes popular Bay access point unpredictable*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is alerting people of the hazardous ice conditions near the I-41 bridge construction site over Duck Creek, just north of the I-43/US 41 interchange, in the village of Howard. The site is a popular access point to the Bay for snowmobilers and ice fisherman.

The bridge pier construction activities restrict snowmobile traffic to the north side of Duck Creek. Due to ongoing construction operations, ice conditions can vary from thin ice to open waters. The daily changes in ice conditions can create a hazard for anyone who ventures near the work site. Please use CAUTION.

These new bridges over Duck Creek are part of the I-41 Project.
