## WIS 29 interchange



Construction on the interchange began in fall of 2012 and is anticipated to be completed by October 2014.



The US 41/WIS 29 interchange is being improved to a multi-level systems interchange with free-flow directional ramps connecting US 41 and WIS 29.

## WIS 29 corridor traffic impacts: 2013 - 2014 (schedule subject to change)

WIS 29 follows newly aligned Shawano Ave

Dousman St permanently closed

Southbound US 41 exit to Mason St accessed by a temporary ramp from Shawano Ave during construction on the Mainline (spring to summer 2013)

## WIS 29 and US 41 closures

Between March and May 2013, WisDOT is planning WIS 29 and US 41 freeway closures to erect tub girders during the WIS 29 system interchange reconstruction.

- The signed route to bypass closures of WIS 29 follows Packerland Drive, Mason Street and Military Avenue
- Alternate routes for thru traffic on US 41 follows WIS 172 and I-43

## County FF construction

While not part of the US 41 Project, construction on the new County FF interchange is anticipated to start late June 2013 through August 2014.
