PROJECT OVERVIEW

The purpose of the Resort Road Wetland Mitigation site project is to provide required mitigation of wetland impacts for the US 41 Corridor Expansion Project in Brown County. The project will excavate material in order to create wetland areas, lengthen existing water channels within the site, place water control structures along those channels, and replace a culvert pipe crossing Resort Road.

During construction you may notice an increase in the amount of truck traffic in your area. Dump trucks will be hauling excavated material to other sites in the area. The contractor will be expected to keep the haul roads clear of debris. If you have any concerns during construction, please do not hesitate to contact us (see contact information).
