MEETING PURPOSE

The primary purpose of today's meeting is to provide the public with firsthand information regarding the construction activities scheduled for the Lombardi Avenue interchange. This meeting will provide updates on:

- 2012 construction activities
- Construction timeline

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will present information about upcoming construction at the Lombardi Avenue interchange. Project staff will be available during the meeting to listen to comments and answer questions.

OPEN HOUSE MEETING FORMAT

Today's meeting will run from 5:30 to 7 p.m. with a short presentation at 5:45 p.m. Current design plans are available for viewing and project staff is on hand to answer questions.



LOMBARDI AVENUE INTERCHANGE

Late March - August 2012

- Traffic on Lombardi Ave is shifted to north lanes while south lanes are reconstructed.
- Traffic on Lombardi Ave is shifted to newly reconstructed south lanes while north lanes are reconstructed.
- The Lombardi Ave interchange ramps will be reconstructed but not closed to traffic.

August - September 2012

- Traffic on Lombardi Ave restricted to one lane in each direction near Wood Ln.



LOMBARDI AVENUE INTERCHANGE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

As part of the Lombardi Avenue interchange reconstruction, the following construction activities will take place at and around the Lombardi Avenue interchange:


2012 work:

- Reconstruct ramp intersections to accommodate dual lane ramps.
- Reconstruct Lombardi Avenue east of US 41 with 6-lane section to tie into Lombardi Avenue.
- Construct a crash investigation site west of US 41.
- Construct dual southbound turn lanes (west to south movement).

- Replace existing rural section west of US 41 with urban section.
- Include extensive landscaping elements.
- Complete grading for future pedestrian accommodations.

Future work beginning in 2013:

- Reconstruct US 41 structure over Lombardi Avenue.
- Construct noise barriers.
- Construct retaining walls and community sensitive design (CSD) elements.
- Reconstruct US 41 mainline.
- Construct dual lanes on entrance and exit ramps.
