Meeting purpose

The primary purpose of these meetings is to provide to the business community, local officials and general public firsthand information about construction activities scheduled for the Lineville Road interchange area. These meetings will provide updates on:

- 2013 construction activities
- Construction schedule
- Road closures and alternate route options
- Temporary signing opportunities for businesses during construction

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will share information about upcoming construction in the Lineville Road interchange area, along with information about alternate routes and temporary signing opportunities that will connect customers with area businesses during construction.


Meeting format

Today's business group meeting will be from 7:30 to 9 a.m. with a brief presentation at 7:45 a.m. The public information meeting will be from 4:30 to 6 p.m. with a brief presentation at 4:45 p.m. Please review the project displays, and feel free to speak with project staff about questions or concerns. A form is available for written comments that can be turned in at the meeting or mailed to WisDOT.

Lineville Road interchange improvements

Lineville Road interchange area work will include:

- Constructing four roundabouts: one at each ramp terminal; one at the intersection of Lineville Road and East Deerfield Avenue; and one at the intersection of Lineville Road and West Deerfield Avenue
- Replacing the Lineville Road bridge over US 41
- Adding bicycle and pedestrian accommodations
- Constructing an additional lane for traffic on Lineville Road
- Constructing a free-flow right-turn lane for eastbound traffic at the southbound on-ramp

Construction and grading work on the Lineville Road interchange will begin in June 2013. The interchange and Lineville Road over US 41 are scheduled to be closed to traffic for 60 days in 2014 - from August to October. The map at left shows the alternative routes for drivers during the closures.



I-43 interchange reconstruction


In fall 2013, early structure work will begin in advance of the reconstruction of the I-43 interchange. Intermittent ramp closures and lane restrictions will occur as part of this work. Reconstruction of the I-43 interchange will begin in fall 2013 and continue through 2017.

Key design features for the interchange include:

- Reconstructing the interchange with directional ramps (all loop ramps eliminated)
- Constructing new bridges over Wietor Drive, Canadian National railroad, I-43 and Duck Creek
- Eliminating existing access between Velp Avenue and I-43 via US 41. Atkinson Drive will be used to access southbound I-43 from Velp Avenue or to access Velp Avenue from northbound I-43

- 2** US 41 mainline reconstruction (Duck Creek to Lineville Road)
Summer 2013 – spring 2015
- 3** Lakeview Drive bridge
Summer 2012 – summer 2013
- 4** I-43 interchange
Fall 2013 – spring 2017
- 5** Velp Avenue interchange
February/March 2015 – spring 2017
- 6** Beaver Dam Creek box culvert, creek realignment, Velp Avenue stormwater pond, Island Court/Lone Grove cul-de-sacs
Spring 2013 – spring 2014
- 7** US 41 mainline reconstruction (Memorial Drive to Duck Creek)
March 2015 – spring 2017



Meetings about upcoming Velp Avenue and I-43 construction areas

In fall 2013, WisDOT will hold meetings with business owners and operators and the public to share additional information about US 41 Project construction staging and traffic impacts in the Velp Avenue interchange and I-43 interchange areas.
