MEETING PURPOSE

The primary purpose of these meetings is to provide the business community and general public with firsthand information regarding the construction activities scheduled in the Mason Street interchange area. Along with the reconstruction of the Mason Street interchange, this meeting will focus on construction along US 41 mainline from 9th Street to Memorial Drive, WIS 29 mainline, Packerland Drive (County EB) ramps, and the newly realigned Shawano Avenue. These meetings will provide updates on:

- 2012 construction activities (details on page 2)
- Overall construction schedule
- Road closures and alternate route options

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will present information about upcoming construction in the Mason Street interchange area and along the WIS 29 corridor, and will also provide information about alternate routes and business signing opportunities that will connect customers with area businesses during construction.


OPEN HOUSE MEETING FORMAT

MASON STREET INTERCHANGE

Construction: Aug 2011 - Oct 2012

- Interchange and Mason/Taylor streets intersection are scheduled to be CLOSED Feb - Aug 2012



PACKERLAND DRIVE (COUNTY EB) RAMPS AND SHAWANO AVENUE


Construction: Feb - Nov 2012

- Construct ramps for half interchanges at Packerland Drive
- Short-term daytime closures
- Potential nighttime closures

Construction: Feb - Nov 2012

- Realign Shawano Avenue

Dousman Street closed for approximately two weeks in late summer 2012



ALTERNATE ROUTES


The Mason Street interchange, including the bridge and all ramps, is currently scheduled to be closed February 1 through August 1, 2012. Alternate routes across US 41 include Larsen Road and 9th Street. The Shawano Avenue and Lombardi Avenue interchanges can be used to access US 41 while the Mason Street interchange is closed. CONSTRUCTION TIMELINES 2011 – 2015

Beginning in early 2012, construction will start on the Mason Street interchange, along with the newly realigned Shawano Avenue north of WIS 29, and on the Packerland Drive (County EB) ramps. The Mason Street interchange, bridge and Mason/Taylor streets intersection are currently scheduled to be CLOSED starting in February and will reopen in August 2012.

Reconstruction of US 41 mainline between 9th Street and Larsen Road is included with the Mason Street interchange project. This segment of US 41 mainline and the Mason Street interchange will be completed by late summer 2012.

Reconstruction of US 41 mainline from Larsen Road to Memorial Drive and WIS 29 mainline will also begin in 2012. The reconstruction of the WIS 29 interchange is scheduled to begin in August 2012. All major construction activities in the vicinity of the Mason and WIS 29 interchanges and the WIS 29 corridor are scheduled to be completed by 2015.



FUTURE OPPORTUNITIES FOR BUSINESS GROUP MEETINGS AND CONSTRUCTION UPDATE MEETINGS

WisDOT will continue to hold business group meetings throughout the project's duration to keep businesses informed. Future business meetings will be held at key milestones, including:

- Annual construction update meetings (every spring until construction is finished)
- Periodic construction update meetings for businesses will be held throughout the projects duration
