About the US 41 Project:


Construction work on the US 41 Project will span over 14 miles in Brown County from 2010-2017, and 17 miles of highway in Winnebago County from 2009-2014.

The project includes:

- traffic lanes expanded from four to six or more lanes depending on the location
- reconstruction of 13 interchanges
- improvements to 16 interchanges
- 40 roundabouts
- 17 traffic cameras installed
- widening the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway to eight lanes, plus a bike/pedestrian trail with fishing access

The **County GG** overpass will be CLOSED while the overpass is reconstructed over **US 41** beginning in March 2014. Utilities will begin relocations in summer 2013. Design features for the new **County GG** overpass will include:

- Two 12-foot driving lanes, 8-foot shoulders, and a 10-foot path for pedestrian, bicycle, and snowmobile access across **US 41**.
- The paths will be separated from the roadway by a concrete barrier.

Work at this overpass will include:

- Reconstructing approximately 1,400 feet of **County GG** east of **US 41** and 1,600 feet west of **US 41**.
- Reconstructing approximately 1,300 feet of **Green Valley Road** through the **County GG** and **Woodenshoe Road** intersections; also reconstructing these intersections.
- Reconstructing approximately 1,100 feet of **Old Dixie Road** through the **County GG** intersection; reconstructing the intersection.
- Constructing a shared use path on the north side of the overpass bridge.
- Constructing shared use path segments between **US 41** and **Green Valley Road** (along the north side of **County GG**), and on a diagonal alignment between **US 41** and **Old Dixie Road**.
