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US 41 Project lane closures for November 4 – November 8

Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing US 41 Project lane restrictions for November 4 – November 8 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Drivers should be aware of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits in both counties and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone. Details of all closures are included below.

NOTE: These closures are for the US 41 Project only

The Leo Frigo Bridge remains closed indefinitely. Please use the WIS 172 bypass or plan an alternate route.

Brown County

US 41

Drivers should anticipate various overnight single lane closures on southbound and northbound US 41 along the entire Brown County corridor from south of Scheuring Road to Lineville Road. Lane closures can vary along the corridor, so drivers are urged to stay alert, pay attention to road signs, slow down and use caution when entering any work zone. The US 41 Project plans to have at least one lane of traffic open at all times on both northbound and southbound US 41 during construction. This does not include closures by local authorities for accidents or unusual incidents (such as weather).

Oneida Street

Drivers can expect various lane closures on eastbound and westbound Oneida Street under US 41 throughout the week from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. In addition, the following ramp closures will be in place:

- Northbound US 41 on-ramp from Oneida Street will be closed nightly Tuesday through Friday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

- Southbound US 41 off-ramp to Oneida Street will be closed nightly on Tuesday through Friday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to Oneida Street will be closed nightly Thursday and Friday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

WIS 172

Please note: Significant traffic pattern change for WIS 172 will take place early morning, Thursday, Nov. 7, before morning rush hour.

- **Thursday morning, Nov. 7, westbound WIS 172 traffic seeking northbound US 41** will be required to ONLY use the right lane as an exit to northbound US 41. Drivers using the center lane will no longer have access to northbound US 41. Traffic seeking southbound US 41 will use the center lane and continue on WIS 172, pass under US 41 and use the temporary ramp to access southbound US 41. The left lane will be for traffic continuing on westbound WIS 172.

Throughout the week, westbound WIS 172 between Ashland Avenue and Babcock Road will have single lane closures from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. for grading operations. The following ramps will have closures:

- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to WIS 172 will be closed nightly Tuesday through Friday from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. for sewer installation. The following detour will be in place:
 - **Northbound US 41** traffic seeking **eastbound** WIS 172 will be detoured off at Ashland Avenue, take Ashland Avenue north to Vanderperren Way, follow Vanderperren Way west to the eastbound WIS 172 entrance ramp
 - **Northbound US 41** traffic seeking **westbound** WIS 172 will take Ashland Avenue north to Pilgrim Way and follow Pilgrim Way to westbound WIS 172
- Northbound US 41 on-ramp from westbound WIS 172 will be closed overnight on Wednesday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - **Westbound WIS 172** traffic seeking northbound US 41 will be detoured off at Pilgrim Way, follow Pilgrim Way east to Ashland Avenue, take Ashland Avenue north to Lombardi Avenue and follow Lombardi Avenue west to northbound US 41

Lombardi Avenue and Mason Street

The following ramps will have closures:

- Southbound US 41 off-ramp to Lombardi Avenue will be closed nightly on Tuesday and Wednesday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Southbound US 41 on-ramp from Mason Street will be closed nightly on Tuesday and Wednesday from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Northbound US 41 on-ramp from Mason Street will be closed overnight on Thursday from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

WIS 29

Drivers can expect a full closure of eastbound WIS 29 between Packerland Drive and northbound US 41 ramps and westbound WIS 29 between northbound US 41 ramps and Dousman Street on Wednesday, November 6 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for bridge work. Traffic will be detoured as follows:

- **Eastbound WIS 29** traffic will take Packerland Drive south to Mason Street, take Mason Street east to Military Avenue and follow Military Avenue north to WIS 29
- **Westbound WIS 29** traffic will take southbound US 41 to Mason Street, take Mason Street west to Packerland Drive and follow Packerland Drive north to WIS 29

There will be a full closure of westbound WIS 29 at US 41 ramps on Thursday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured as follows:

- **Westbound WIS 29** traffic will take Military Avenue south to Mason Street, take Mason Street west to Packerland Drive and follow Packerland Drive north to WIS 29

The following ramps will also be closed:

- Southbound US 41 off-ramp to WIS 29 will be closed nightly on Wednesday and Thursday from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Traffic will be detoured:
 - **Southbound US 41** traffic seeking **eastbound WIS 29** traffic will exit at Mason Street, take Mason Street east to Military Avenue and follow Military Avenue north to WIS 29
 - **Southbound US 41** traffic seeking **westbound WIS 29** traffic will exit at Mason Street, take Mason Street west to Packerland Drive and follow Packerland Drive north to WIS 29
- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to WIS 29 will be closed overnight on Thursday from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Traffic will be detoured:
 - **Northbound US 41** traffic seeking **eastbound WIS 29** traffic will exit at Mason Street, take Mason Street east to Military Avenue and follow Military Avenue north to WIS 29

- **Northbound US 41** traffic seeking **westbound WIS 29** traffic will exit at Mason Street, take Mason Street west to Packerland Drive and follow Packerland Drive north to WIS 29

Velp Avenue

Drivers can anticipate overnight single lane closures on eastbound and westbound Velp Avenue between Island Court and Memorial Drive nightly on Tuesday through Thursday from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. The following ramps will also be closed:

- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to Velp Avenue will be closed on Wednesday from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Northbound US 41 on-ramp from Velp will be closed Friday night, Nov. 8, 8 p.m. through Sunday morning, Nov. 10, 8 a.m.
- Northbound US 41 off-ramp will be closed Friday, Nov. 8 and Saturday, Nov. 9 from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. nightly.
- During the day Saturday, Nov. 9, traffic exiting onto Velp from northbound US 41 will only be able to make a right turn on Velp. No left turn onto westbound Velp will be permitted during this time period.

County B

The following ramp will be closed:

- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to County B will be closed on Wednesday from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m. and on Thursday from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Winnebago County

US 41

Drivers can expect lane restrictions on US 41 near the County G overpass construction.

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
